C'est ainsi qu'une grande partie de la vie culturelle et des traditions juives furent perdues à jamais. Aujourd'hui, l'antisémitisme est répandu en Ukraine, et le stéréotype négatif du «juif» trouve son content d'adeptes parmi les Ukrainiens. Il existe cependant toujours des communautés juives dans de nombreuses villes ukrainiennes qui s'agrandissent, trouvant des soutiens parmi les juifs endehors de l'Ukraine.

## OLHA KOBYLYANSKA CHERNIVTSI ACADEMIC MUSIC AND DRAMA THEATRE: FROM THE PAST TO THE PRESENT

Chernivtsi is one of the most beautiful and unique places in Ukraine. This beautiful city with wonderful architecture, museums, shady alleys in its parks and gardens, summer cafes, which can be found round every corner, attracts tourists from all over the country and abroad. They come to admire the past and the present, which blend so harminously together. Chernivtsi has been the home for many outstanding authors and artists. Ukrainian classical writers Yuriy Fedkovych and Olha Kobylyanska lived and worked for some time here. The citizens keep memory of the famous people: there are two memorial museums dedicated to the life and litarary activity of these outstanding personalities. The most beautiful street in the city centre and the Academic Music and Drama Theatre of Chernivtsi were named after Olha Kobylyanska. The building of the theatre is one of the most beautiful architectural monuments in the city. It was built in 1905 by the Austrian architects F. Fellner and G. Hellmer who also built Vienna (Austria) and Odessa (Ukraine) opera houses, due to this fact Chernivtsi theatre looks quite similar to them.

In our research we are trying to investigate the history of the theatre and to show its development and growth from the past up to the present days. We examine the history and the development of Olha Kobylyanska Chernivtsi Academic Music and Drama Theatre, considering not only its architucture but also such things as its first troupe of actors and its importance in the social and cultural life of the city. In our paper we used mostly historical notes, journals, periodicals and books on Chernivtsi history, books and journals on the city architucture and mass media information, concerning contemporary events in the city like, for example, the

former first lady visit to participate in the theatre's 80th anniversary and the issue of the coin, dedicated to the theatre's 100th anniversary, by the National Bank of Ukraine.

The history of the professional theatre started in Kharkiv, when a new troupe of actors was organized in November 1931. In July 1940 the troupe moved to Chernivtsi. Olha Kobylyanska Academic Music and Drama Theater of Chernivtsi was built in 1904-1905 by Fellner and Helmer architect bureau. The firm specialized in theatre construction and designed 48 theatre buildings in Europe. The building of the theatre has Vienna modernist features with the elements of baroque style. Initially the city coat of arms was placed above the pediment. The fasade is decorated with sculpture compositions placed above the entrance and side windows. Above the front windows busts of William Shakespeare and Richard Wagner and placed. Other walls show busts of Shevchenko, Pushkin, Goethe, Schiller, Beethoven, Schubert, Mozart, Haydn. However, the real pearl of the theatre is the magic mirrow, which is located on the second floor of the theatre and is believed to make the wishes come true.

Olha Kobylyanska Chernivtsi Academic Music and Drama Theatre is an architectural masterpiece of the beginning of 20th century and a real adornment of the city. The Austrian publicist G. Heinzen said about this magnificent building the following: "Chernivtsi Theatre is a dream made of emerald and gold, designed by Vienna architects Hellmer and Fellner." Nowadays, this wonderful architectural masterpiece turned into a city's main touristic spots and truly became a city's monument of architecture and fabulous history.
